Read Together:

Matthew 1:1-2

This is **<u>the genealogy of Jesus the Messiah</u> the <u>son of David</u>, the son of <u>Abraham</u>: Abraham was the father of <mark>Isaac</mark>, Isaac the father of <mark>Jacob</mark>, Jacob the father of <mark>Judah</mark> and his brothers**

Matthew 2:11

On coming to the house, they saw the child with his mother Mary, and they **bowed** <mark>down</mark> and <mark>worshiped him</mark>. Then they opened their treasures and <mark>presented him</mark> with gifts of gold, frankincense and myrrh.

Matthew 2:2

…"<u>Where is the one who has been born king of the Jews</u>? We saw his star when it rose and have come to worship him."

Matthew 3:17

And a voice from heaven said, "<mark>This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well</mark> <mark>pleased</mark>."

Matthew 4:8-9

Again, the devil took him to a very high mountain and showed him all the kingdoms of the world and their splendor. "<mark>All this I will give you</mark>," he said, "<mark>if you will bow</mark> <mark>down and worship me</mark>."

Discuss Together:

- How does Jesus' genealogy connect him to the story of Israel? Why is this significant?
- The genealogy of Jesus includes unexpected people–women, foreigners, and those with broken pasts. What does this teach us about God's Kingdom and who He includes?
- How does Jesus' baptism parallel Israel's story in the Old Testament? What does this tell us about his mission?
- What was the Jewish expectation for a Messiah, and how does Matthew claim that Jesus fulfills this role?
- Matthew highlights how God brings redemption out of failure. Can you think of a time when God used a failure in your life for something greater?
- What is the significance of the Magi worshiping Jesus and bringing him gifts? How do you personally respond to Jesus in your life?
- How does Jesus' use of Scripture in resisting temptation serve as a model for us today?
