Read the following scriptures together.

Ephesians 1:4-6

For <u>he chose us in him before the creation of the world</u> to be <u>holy and</u> <u>blameless</u> in his sight. <u>In love</u>, he <u>predestined us for adoption to sonship</u> through Jesus Christ, in accordance with his pleasure and will— <u>to the praise of his glorious</u> <u>grace</u>, which he has freely given us in the One he loves.

Ephesians 1:13

And you also were included in Christ when you heard the message of truth, the gospel of your salvation. When you believed, you were marked in him with a seal, the promised Holy Spirit,

Ephesians 1:8-10

...With all wisdom and understanding, <u>he made known to us the mystery of his will</u> according to his good pleasure, <u>which he purposed in Christ</u>, to be put into effect when the times reach their fulfillment—<u>to bring unity to all things in heaven and on earth under Christ</u>.
